The Romans used these capital letters:


I

These letters were put together to form all the numbers, like this:
$\mathrm{I}=1$
II $=2$
III $=3$
IV = 4
$V=5$
$\mathrm{VI}=6$
$\mathrm{VII}=7$
VIII $=8$
IX = 9

There are two rules you need to know:

1. put a letter after a larger one means you add it.
2. put a letter before a larger one means you take it away.

So $\mathrm{XI}_{\text {is }} 10+1=11$ and $\mathrm{IX}_{\text {is }} 10-1=9$

$$
C X \text { is } 100+10=110 \text { and } X C \text { is } 100-10=90
$$
